### Additional notes:

- Groups will stay less than 10 people and practice good “social distancing”
- Specific locations can be modified based on the interest of the participants
- Individual churches would serve as the team leader for individual locations, for example Fullerton Free will take St. Jude. However, this does not mean only Fullerton Free people can sign up to pray for St. Jude, nor does it mean that people from a specific church can only pray for a specific project.
- We will provide a copy of The Circle Maker and chalk to each team leader.
- We will need to develop a sheet of suggestions on how to prayer walk.
- Each participating church could adopt the location for longer term prayer.
